RWBA 600 CLUB “MAE JACKSON MEMORIAL 3-6-9 DOUBLES TOURNAMENT” RULES
October 24, 2026

1. This will be a Doubles 3-6-9 Tournament for all sanctioned CAUSBCA adult bowlers. This is a handicap tournament – 90% of 230 consisting of three divisions.
2. Doubles partners may include any combination of partners (Female/Female; Female/Male; Male/Male). We will have 3 divisions for all original entries (dependent upon # of entries) and 2 divisions for all Ghost entries, 3rd Ghost division may be added if more than 50 Ghost teams sign up. Each division will compete only against teams within their division.
3. There will be one squad. Check in will begin at 8:30AM, announcements 9:20 AM and bowling starts promptly at 9:30 AM. You must check in **at least 30 minutes prior to starting time**. Entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis until full (70 teams maximum). No “Walk In” entries will be accepted.
4. Eligibility requirements: Must be a current adult CAUSBCA sanctioned bowler in good standing and with an average that can be verified on Bowl.com.
5. Entrants will use their highest 2025-2026 sanctioned USBC Yearbook average (Sport League averages will be adjusted according to the USBC Adjustment Scale); or if they have no 2025-2026 year-end Yearbook average, they will use their highest 2026 Summer average. If neither of the above are available, they will use their USBC current season average as of October 10th with a minimum of twelve (12) games. If none of the above applies, entrant must bowl scratch (230 average).
6. It shall be his or her responsibility to verify the accuracy of their average. Failure to use the proper average or make correction up to the completion of the first game of a series shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than actual average, or base winnings on submitted average if it is higher. Rule 319d will apply – If a bowler who has qualified for a prize of \$600 or more in the past 12 months in any event, he/she must report actual score, position, and amount won to Tournament Director for possible re-rating PRIOR to start of his/her entry into tournament. Failure to comply will result in forfeit of fees and winnings.
7. Bowlers with no Bowl.com average **must** provide average verification signed by their league secretary for the current season and as of October 10th, 2026. If you bowl in more than 1 league, you need to use your highest average. Average verification must be mailed with your application or turned in at check in.
8. After entries have been received and processed by the Tournament Director, no fees shall be refunded (exception, see Rule 9 below). Entry fees shall be paid by check or money order. Cash will be accepted if turning in to tournament director or to one of the Buffalo Lanes managers. Make checks payable to: RWBA 600 Club. A \$35.00 service fee will be charged for returned checks. Scores bowled by an entrant(s) of a returned check are subject to disqualification.
9. The Tournament Director has the right to rerate or reject any entry. If rerating is necessary, the bowler will be notified prior to start of tournament. However, if the rerated average is not accepted by the bowler, the entry fee shall be refunded (USBC Rule #319c).
10. Prize money will be mailed within 30 days after end of tournament. The prize fund will be established based on the Division entries. In the case of a tie, prize money will be combined and distributed equally.
11. No practicing is allowed on any tournament lanes one (1) hour prior to starting time.
12. Entrants will bowl four (4) games, receiving automatic strikes in the 3rd, 6th and 9th frames of each game. Highest combined doubles series plus handicap will determine the winners. If anyone cannot complete all 4 games, you will receive zero (0) for any game not bowled. Teams will remain on the same pair for all 4 games. No position change in the line-up of the bowlers is allowed. All bowlers must remain on their lanes and be prepared to bowl, or you will forfeit the scores you miss. You must keep pace.
13. RWBA 600 Club Members are encouraged to wear full tournament uniform (Navy pants/skirts/shorts and 600 Club Shirts or plain white or red top, local chevron on left sleeve and national chevron on right sleeve).
14. Telescores are the official scores. Bowlers are responsible for checking their own scores while bowling. All bowlers will sign individual score sheets when the block of four games is completed. Any errors in scoring during play should be corrected immediately by a Tournament Official. Other errors should be reported to the Tournament Director within 15 minutes after the tournament is over.
15. Any bowler unable to participate in the tournament should notify the Tournament Director at least 24 hours prior to tournament time. Substitutes may be permitted pending average verification.
16. The use of such substances as Powder, Easy Slide, Rosin, Pumice, Aerosol, etc., on shoes, or the use of soft rubber soles and/or heels that rub off, and in any manner alter the normal conditions of the approach is strictly prohibited.
17. Any rule not covered within shall be governed by USBC Rules. Any questions not covered by these rules will be decided by the Tournament Director and the RWBA 600 Club Board of Directors.

If they have no **2025-2026 USBC Yearbook Average, they can use their 2026 Summer highest average.** If that is not available, they will use their highest USBC current season average as of **October 10, 2026 with a minimum of twelve (12) games.** Those entrants who do not have an average from the options above will bowl scratch (230 average). The Tournament Director has the right to rerate or reject any entry. If current average is to be used, bowlers must provide average verification signed by League Secretary and mailed with their application form or turned in at check in.
